- Funding Challenges

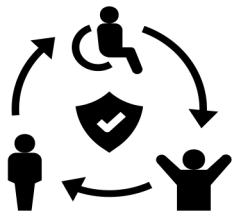

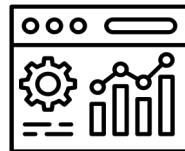

A Roadmap For Driving Progress toward Equity in Trauma Research



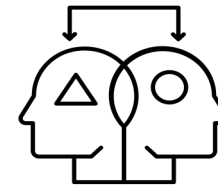
Study all phases of injury care:
